What kind of boats are in the Aqua Boat Club?

Our fleet includes a MasterCraft XT20, Cobalt 24SD and Regal 2100 Surf. As of 2019, we are proud to welcome two new vessels: a 2019 Cobalt R5 Surf and 2019 Moomba Makai. This line-up will offer a diverse mix between sport and leisure for the whole family.

Can anyone become a member?

Members must be at least 25 years of age and have a valid driver's license. All members must pass a brief safety certification with boaterexam.com/canada/bc/ prior to becoming a member.

How do I become a member?

Can I split a membership with a friend?

Yes! However, both parties would share the same credentials for our Boat Cloud booking app.

How do I reserve a boat?

Members can make reservations directly from the Boat Cloud booking app on your smartphone. If you do not have access to the internet, you can call us at **250.764.0808** to book a session.

How long is a session?

Each boat can be booked for a morning session from 7am–1pm or an evening session from 2pm – Sunset.

How many sessions can I book?

Each member can have a maximum of three sessions reserved at any given time. However, members enjoy an unlimited number of boat outings throughout the season.

Can I book a session last-minute?

Absolutely! If a boat is available, we will have it ready for you within an hour.

How do I know boats will be available?

Our booking system and low member-to-boat ratio create a fair and open schedule where you won't feel like you're competing with other members for session times. We want our boats to feel like your boats.

Is there a charge for canceling a reservation?

There is no charge for cancellation – however, no-shows are subject to a \$25 slush fund fee. The boats are here to be used at your convenience, but we hate to have a boat sitting idle when a fellow member could be out on the water.

How much does it cost?

The price to be a member of Aqua Boat Club is substantially less than the average annual cost of owning a boat! **View our membership options at aquaboatclub.com.**

Who cleans and maintains the boats?

All boats are professionally maintained by a Martin Motor Sports marine certified technician. Each boat is fueled, inspected, and detailed before your arrival.

Do you have additional equipment available?

Yes! We offer unlimited use of coast guard rated life vests, surfboards, and tubes for our members.

Is the insurance covered by the Club?

Yes! Our insurance policy is specifically aligned with our business and covers major damage and liability. However, you may be held responsible for the repairs of minor damage to the boat or any equipment.

Can I bring guests?

Yes! You can bring as many guests as the boat capacity allows.

Can my guests use the club boats without me?

No, but they will continue to be your friend as long as you are the boat captain!

Are there any hidden fees or surprises I should know about?

The only additional expense is the fuel you use.

Do I need to be an experienced captain to join the club?

No prior experience is necessary or required. We offer orientations with each vessel you choose until you feel comfortable operating it yourself. If you have trouble setting up a surf wave or standing on one, we can help you with that too.

How long does my membership last?

Memberships last for the entire summer season from May 1st – September 30th.
